hile these are times of change for the Women of the Moose, their numbers are growing.

That was the positive news Grand Chancellor Barb McPherson delivered at the International Convention in New Orleans.

During the 2023-24 campaign, 62 percent of WOTM chapters showed an increase – and the overall gain was 1,101. That gave the organization back-to-back years of increased membership.

McPherson said that the Women of the Moose remain an organization in transition. Through 2023-24, 58 chapters closed or merged with other chapters.

"Eight of those chapters were over 100 years old," McPherson said. "I just don't understand how chapters can endure through tough times yet when they should be celebrating success they choose not to survive."


McPherson pointed to the increased leadership influence women have in The Moose. At the association level, there are 160 female officers, and women are the majority of some association boards. Women are also joining The Moose in droves. For example, 72,597 women joined the Fraternity in 2023-24.

"The Women of the Moose are still a very powerful force within the organization. We bring new skills and talents to our lodges to make them better and stronger. The same is true in many of our associations," McPherson said.


McPherson addressed the continued modernization of the Women of the Moose, but she said, "My advice for dealing with change is to take baby steps. While you are doing it, remember why we exist as an organization and why the Women of the Moose are a very vital part of this Fraternity. We continue to provide daily needs for those who depend on us at Mooseheart and Moosehaven."

Overall, McPherson said, "It's not all gloom and doom. Many of our chapters are flourishing. They are the ones that meet more than once a month and are having fun, interesting and informative get togethers to keep their members interested. They are filling the need for human interaction with activities and personal relationships."

McPherson also noted that, "Several chapters who previously closed now realize that they miss the fun, dedication and personal interaction of their chapter and want to start over."














